GS1 Belarus

- GS1 AISBL ("GS1")**, (formerly called EAN International), is an international not-for-profit association incorporated under Belgian law with registered office located in Brussels, Belgium. GS1 currently has a membership of 112 nationally based Member Organisations. GS1 manages a worldwide, multi-industry standards system enabling the automatic identification of products and services in the supply chain, electronic commerce and global data synchronisation ("**GS1 System**"). The GS1 System comprises the GS1 barcoding, electronic commerce and RFID (radio frequency identification) standards.
- GS1 Member Organisations** are authorised by GS1 to administer the GS1 System and services in their respective territory and are GS1's sole representative in their territory. To ensure the integrity of the GS1 standards systems and the global uniqueness of GS1 identification numbers, there can only be one GS1 Member Organisation per country.
- GS1 Belarus - Association of Automatic Identification** (trading as "**GS1 Belarus**"), a non-profit association registered in the Republic of Belarus under registration number 101531917 in the State business register with its place of business at 22 Sudmalis Street 220033 Minsk, Belarus, is the member organisation of GS1 for Belarus. GS1 has granted GS1 Belarus exclusive authorisation to administer the GS1 System in Belarus and allocate GS1 identification numbers to companies, for their supply chain management needs, including Global Company Prefix ("GCP"), Global Location Number ("GLN"), and Global Trade Item Number ("GTIN"). GS1 Belarus is the sole representative of GS1 in Belarus. GS1 Belarus has exclusive permission from GS1 to administer the **GS1 Prefix 481** in Belarus, which prefix is a globally unique code but does not identify the country of origin for a given product.
- Trademarks.** By virtue of its membership to GS1 and the Agreement on Intellectual Property and Data Management signed with GS1, GS1 Belarus has the exclusive right to use the 'GS1' trademarks in Belarus.
- Copyright Rights.** GS1 Belarus has the exclusive right to copy, translate, reproduce and distribute GS1 publications including the GS1 General Specifications, the GS1 Global User Manual, the GS1 EANCOM manual and other publications published from time to time by GS1. These copyright rights include the right to produce publications that derive from and are compliant with GS1 standards and publications.



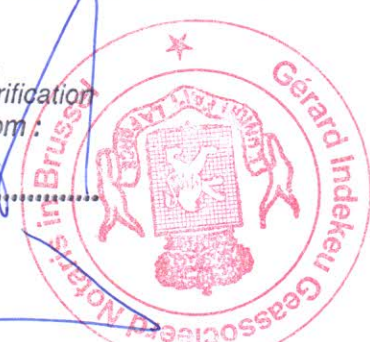


